

CT Pulmonary Angiography

In addition to the May 2020 MBS update of the CT Angiography item numbers, a new item for CT Angiography of the Pulmonary Arteries was created (effective from November 2020).

Points to note as highlighted in the item description:

- Exclusion of pulmonary embolism does not require the GP to indicate a discussion between the GP and a Specialist or Consultant physician took place
- Exclusion of pulmonary arterial stenosois, occlusion or aneurysm does require the GP to indicate a discussion between the GP and a Specialist or Consultant physician took place

MBS ITEM NUMBER AND DESCRIPTION

These item numbers include any scans performed before intravenous contrast injection – one or more data acquisitions, including image editing, and maximum intensity projections or 3 dimensional surface shaded display, with hardcopy or digital recording of multiple projections.

CT ANGIO PULMONARY ARTERIES

Computed tomography—angiography with intravenous contrast medium of any or all, or any part, of the pulmonary arteries and their branches, including any scans performed before intravenous contrast injection, if:

- the service is not a service to which another item in this group applies; and
- the service is not a study performed to image the coronary arteries; and
- the service is:
 - performed for the exclusion of pulmonary arterial stenosis, occlusion, aneurysm or embolism and is requested by a specialist or consultant physician; or
 - performed for the exclusion of pulmonary arterial stenosis, occlusion or aneurysm and is requested by a medical practitioner (other than a specialist or consultant physician) and the request indicates that the patient's case has been discussed with a specialist or consultant physician; or
 - iii for the exclusion of pulmonary embolism and is requested be a medical practitioner (other than a specialist or consultant physician)

Please note: CT of the coronary arteries is covered under a separate item number and is currently not available for GP rebate.
